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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Kitchen garbage •Futon •Wood chips•Scrap paper</li><li>•Cloth waste •Plastic products</li><li>•Soiled plastic packaging</li></ul> <p>Remove excess moisture from kitchen garbage.<br/>If the futon does not fit in the largest designated bag, please cut open the side of the largest designated bag, wrap it around the futon, and put it out for collection.<br/>Place pruning branches in designated garbage bag or tie them together, ensuring they are <b>no longer than 50 cm and no thicker than 10 cm</b>.<br/>Place plastic containers and packaging that cannot be thoroughly cleaned in burnable garbage.</p> |                           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Small electrical appliances •Glassware •Metallic items •Pottery •Plastic packaging</li></ul> <p>Wrap broken glassware, tableware, and knives in paper or cloth and label them as “キケン” (Dangerous).<br/>Only clean plastic containers and packaging bearing the plastic symbol are eligible.Heavily soiled items must be placed in “burnable waste” even if they bear the plastic symbol. </p> <p>Small home appliances can also be disposed of via collection boxes.<br/>Remove the <b>lithium-ion battery</b> due to the risk of fire.</p> |                  | <p>Only items with the PET mark are eligible.<br/>Rinse PET plastic bottles in water and remove the caps and labels.</p> <p><b>Cans Glass bottles</b> </p> <p>•Aluminum cans•Steel cans<br/>•Glass bottles</p> <p>Dispose of spray cans after using up the contents completely without puncturing them.<br/>Cans that cannot be cleaned (such as paint cans) should be disposed of as non-burnable waste.</p>                                                                                                                                        | <p><b>2nd and 4th Thursday</b></p> | <p><b>Materials subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•TVs•Washing Machines•Tumble Dryers</li><li>•Air Conditioners•Refrigerators•Freezers</li></ul> <p>Ask the original vendor or the store where you plan to purchase a replacement to dispose of the item.<br/>If you want to dispose of the item yourself, buy a recycling ticket and take the item to a designated drop-off point.</p> <p><b>Personal Computer</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Personal Computer</li><li>•Computer Monitor</li></ul> <p>Please check with the manufacturer for disposal instructions.<br/>If you do not know the manufacturer, please check with the PC 3R Promotion Association.<br/>PC 3R Promotion Association TEL044-540-0576</p> <p><b>Others</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Construction waste•Bricks•Soil, sand</li><li>•Concrete•Farm equipment</li><li>•Fire extinguishers•Car parts</li><li>•Medical waste•Motorcycle•Car battery</li></ul> <p>Lithium-ion batteries can be disposed of by taking them to a incineration plant.<br/>Please get in touch with the original vendor or waste disposal company.</p> |

Cut the tatami mats into four pieces before disposing of them.</p>                                                                                                              |                  | <p><b>Hazardous waste</b> </p> <p><b>1st Monday of May and August</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Dry cell battery •Fluorescent light</li><li>•Mercury Thermometers</li></ul> <p>Place dry-cell batteries in a transparent or translucent bag.<br/>Place fluorescent lamps in their original packaging (or similar boxes).<br/>The locations for hazardous waste collection are listed in the January issue of “Kohhoh Kawai” and on the Kawai Town website.<br/>Lithium-ion batteries cannot be disposed of as hazardous waste.</p> |                                    |                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                    |
