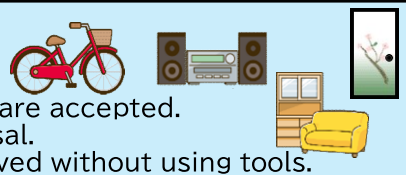

Waste Classification	Main Items & How to Dispose	
Burnable waste	 Designated bag Large Medium Small For trash chutes	Food waste, wood waste, paper waste, cloth and fabric items, plastic products, and soiled plastic containers and packaging Drain excess water from food waste. Tree branches must be 50 cm or less in length and 10 cm or less in diameter. Plastic containers and packaging only if oil stains cannot be removed by washing. 
Non-burnable waste	 Designated bag Large Medium Small	Small electrical appliances, glass items, metal items, ceramics, and clean plastic containers and packaging Always remove all batteries from electrical appliances. Wrap broken items and sharp objects in paper and label them 「危険」 ("DANGER"). Plastic containers and packaging must display the plastic recycling symbol shown here and be clean. 
Bulky waste	 Large-item disposal sticker: 1 per item	Furniture, large household appliances, building fittings, bicycles, etc. Only large items that do not fit in the designated bags are accepted. Tatami mats must be cut into four pieces before disposal. Building fittings are accepted only if they can be removed without using tools. 
PET plastic bottles	 Clear or semi-transparent white bags (contents must be visible)	For beverages, alcohol, and seasonings (with recycling mark) Rinse the inside, remove the cap, and peel off the label. Dispose of the cap and label as "Non-Burnable Waste" . 
Cans Glass bottles and jars	 Clear or semi-transparent white bags (contents must be visible)	Cans (beverage cans, alcoholic beverage cans, food cans, snack cans, cassette gas canisters, etc.) Glass bottles and jars (for beverages, alcoholic drinks, seasonings, jam, etc.) Rinse the inside. Gas/spray cans must be completely emptied (no hole punching needed). Spray cans with paint or other residue, such as lacquer spray cans, are non-burnable waste. 
Hazardous waste	 Batteries / Thermometers: Clear or semi-transparent bags Fluorescent tubes / Light bulbs: Product's box or protective packaging to prevent breakage	Dry batteries, button batteries, fluorescent tubes, light bulbs, mercury thermometers/blood pressure monitors Electronic thermometers: remove batteries and dispose as "Non-Burnable Waste" . LED lights: dispose as "Non-Burnable Waste" . Lithium-ion batteries: "Not Collectable" (accepted only when brought directly to the waste processing center) 

Notice from the Waste Processing Center

The distribution of designated bags for PET plastic bottles, cans, and glass bottles and jars has ended. From October, please use clear or semi-transparent white bags.

Any designated bags you still have at home may continue to be used.

※Waste in bags whose contents cannot be seen will not be collected.

※A semi-transparent white bag is one through which printed text on a newspaper can be seen.

※Whenever possible, please place cans and glass bottles and jars in separate bags.

Collection Boxes for Small Electrical Appliances and Used Cooking Oil

Small Electrical Appliances

Accepted items: Small electrical appliances that fit through the collection box opening (25 cm × 10 cm)

※Remove all batteries before placing items in the collection box.

Locations: Town Hall Main Building, Town Community Center, Town Hall Branch Office, Mameyama-no-Sato Welfare Center, and Town Library



Used Cooking Oil

Accepted items: Liquid vegetable cooking oil only (no solid fats or machine oil)

Locations: Town Hall Main Building and Town Community Center



Waste Not Collected

Appliances covered by the Home Appliance Recycling Act (TVs, freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners, washing machines, and clothes dryers)

Personal computers and monitors

Lithium-ion batteries (accepted only when brought directly to the waste processing center)

Construction waste, bricks, soil, sand, concrete, safes, agricultural equipment, automobile parts, medical waste, etc.
